PRIMARY CARE CLINIC

Primary care clinics are the **first step** for medical care and advice.

They provide:

- Treatment when you are sick with illnesses like a severe cold, the flu, sore throat or earache
- Treatment for chronic conditions like arthritis, diabetes, COPD and heart disease
- Access to laboratory and X-ray services
- Physicals, including gynecology
- Vaccinations
- Treatment of minor injuries, including stitches
- Minor procedures

WALK-IN CLINIC

The Walk-In Clinic offers diagnosis and treatment of **sudden illnesses and injuries**.

Walk-In Clinics provide:

- Treatment when you are sick with illnesses like a severe cold, the flu, sore throat or earache
- Treatment of injuries like sprains, strains and broken bones
- Laboratory and X-ray services

Walk-In Clinics are for patients 6 months and older who don't have a primary care provider or those needing extended office hours. It can help patients get follow-up care at a primary care clinic.

EMERGENCY ROOM

Emergency rooms handle **serious illnesses and injuries**, such as:

- Accidents with major injuries or bleeding
- Deep cuts
- Gunshot or other violence
- Heart attack symptoms – chest pain, pain in jaw or arm or sudden weakness, dizziness or sweating
- Severe breathing problems
- Stroke symptoms – sudden numbness, slurred speech, severe headache or weakness on one side of the body or face
- Sudden confusion or disorientation
- Unconsciousness
